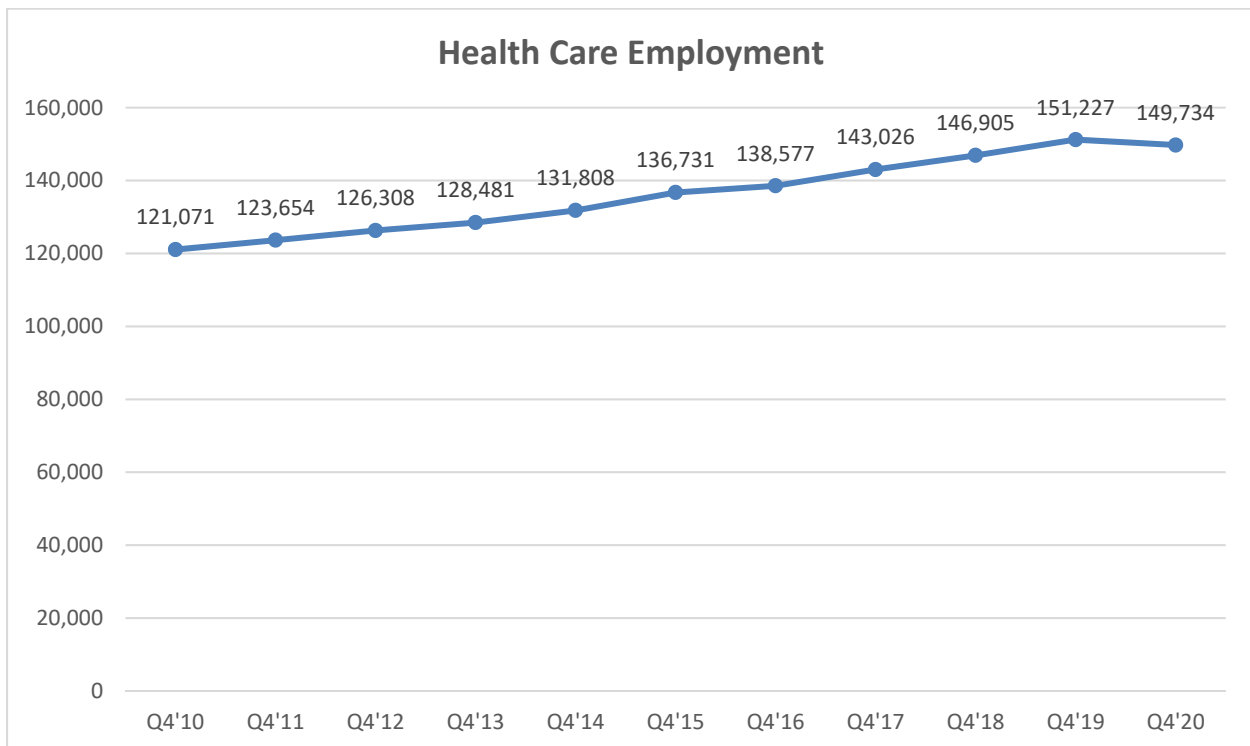


Figure 1: Health Care Employment Trend in Central Valley from Q4 2010 to Q4 2020

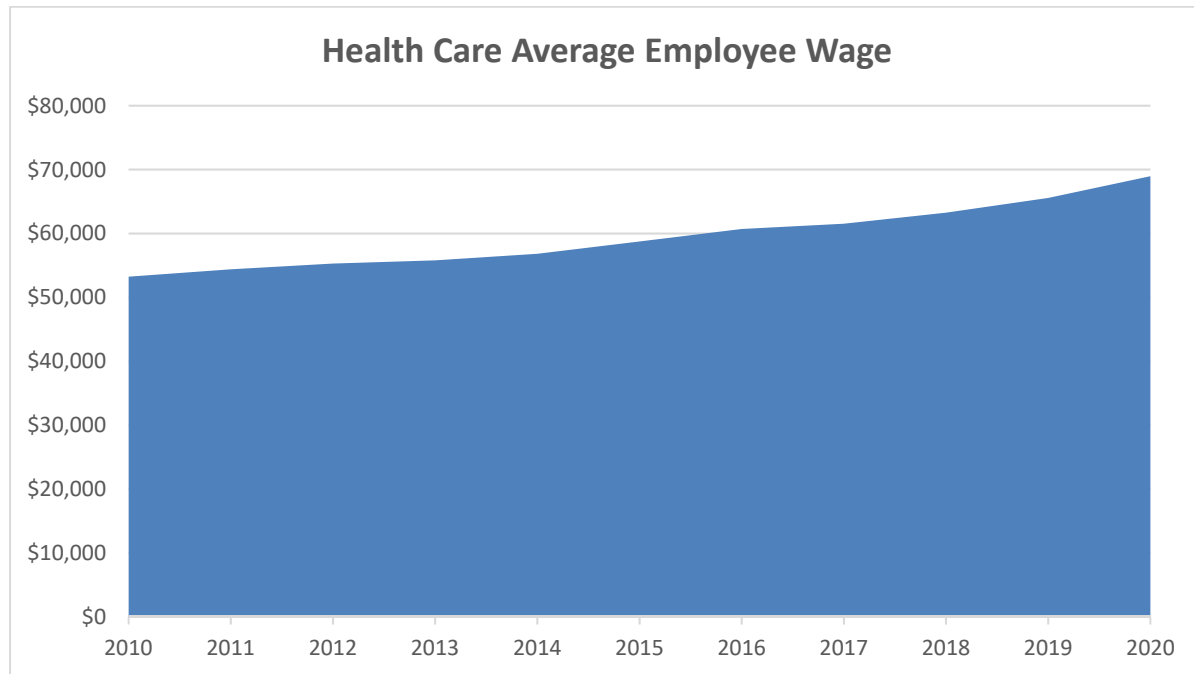


Figure 2: Health Care Historical Wage Trend in Central Valley from 2010 to 2020
